



## MHR NON-NURSING DRESS CODE

### PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to describe the professional dress code of MHR panel members.

### Scope

This policy applies to:

- MHR Panel Members
- MHR Office Personnel
- MHR Clients

Excluding locum doctors, ambulance personnel and pharmacy personnel as their dress code will be determined / prescribed by the client.

### Policy Statement

Panel members will be dressed appropriately and convey a professional image at all times.

### Procedure

Step	Action
1	Wear the prescribed uniform for females as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MHR Tunic top available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• MHR pants or skirt available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• White tops</li> <li>• Black court shoes</li> <li>• MHR fleece jacket or black jersey/jacket in the winter season (to be removed when entering the department/hospital)</li> </ul>
2	Wear the prescribed uniform for males as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MHR shirt available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• MHR pants available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• White shirt</li> <li>• Black shoes</li> <li>• Black/grey socks</li> <li>• Neat tie</li> <li>• MHR fleece jacket or black jersey/jacket in the winter season (to be removed when entering the department/hospital)</li> </ul>

**Procedure, continued**

Step	Action
3	<p>Prescribed uniform for care workers:</p> <p>Female:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MHR Tunic top (Nursing range) available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• MHR pants or skirt (Nursing range) available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• Black court/flat shoes. No clogs, crocks, sandals or slip-on's allowed</li> <li>• Skin colour stockings</li> <li>• MHR fleece jacket or black jersey/jacket in the winter season (to be removed when entering the department/hospital)</li> </ul> <p>Male:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MHR Tunic (Nicholas or Roger) top available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• MHR pants available at MHR offices at subsidised rates</li> <li>• MHR fleece jacket or black jersey/jacket in the winter season (to be removed when entering the department/hospital)</li> <li>• Black/grey socks</li> <li>• Black shoes. No clogs, crocks, sandals or slip-on's allowed</li> </ul>
4	Wear the MHR identification tag whilst on duty
5	Wear the minimum jewellery whilst on duty. Remove all visible body piercing and cover any visible tattoos.
6	Keep hair neat and tidy.
7	Men must be clean-shaven or neatly trimmed moustache/beard, depending on preference.
